Key Responsibilities

Duties will include archaeological construction monitoring, survey, testing, and data recovery, as well as other tasks as assigned. Position requires familiarity with artifact identification, identification of soil stratigraphy, and the identification of archaeological features; as well as the preparation of detailed field notes and archaeological site records. Candidates must be able and willing to work outdoors in remote locations and for extended periods under all weather conditions, often traversing rugged terrain. Must demonstrate awareness for workplace safety; and be willing to work independently when conditions are appropriate or with limited supervision.

- Knowledge of computers and GPS equipment
- Ability/willingness to travel
- At least two years experience working around construction crews and working safely in trenches and around heavy machinery
